

Quick How-To: How to Recognize a Scam Email

Step 1: Be Careful with Unexpected or Unknown Emails

- If you don't know or recognize the sender, be cautious.

Step 2: Watch for Warning Signs

- Look for spelling mistakes or strange wording.
Be suspicious of urgent messages: "Act now!" or "Click this link fast!"
- Do not open unknown links or attachments.

Step 3: Never Share Personal Info

- Passwords or Social Security numbers are never requested by email.
- If you receive an email asking for personal info, and recognize the company, reach out and verify.

Step 4: When in Doubt, Delete It

- If something doesn't feel right, delete the email.
- You can also ask a family member or trusted friend to double check it with you.
