## How to Adjust Accessibility Settings (Text Size, Contrast, etc.)

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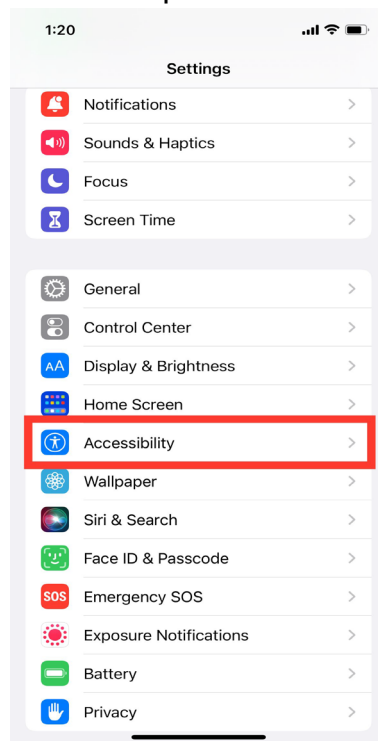
### Who is this for?

This guide is for learners who want to make their device easier to see and use — by changing the text size, color contrast, or enabling voice features.

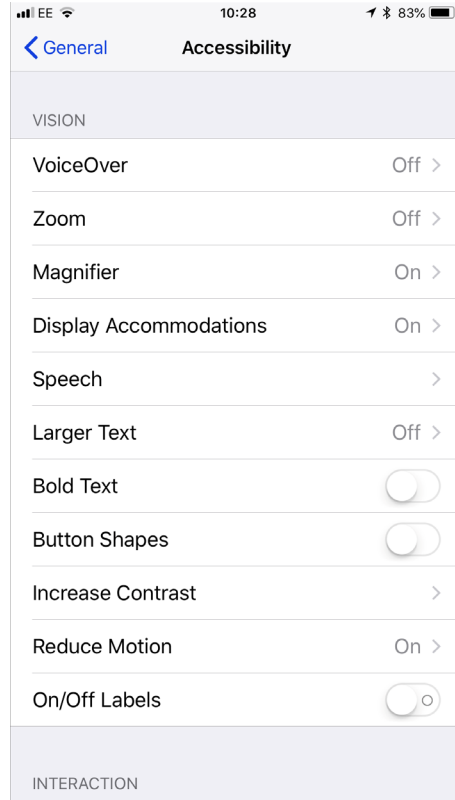
### Step-by-Step Instructions

#### Step 1: Open Settings

- On your phone or tablet, tap **Settings**.
- On the drop-down menu tap the **Accessibility, Display, or**

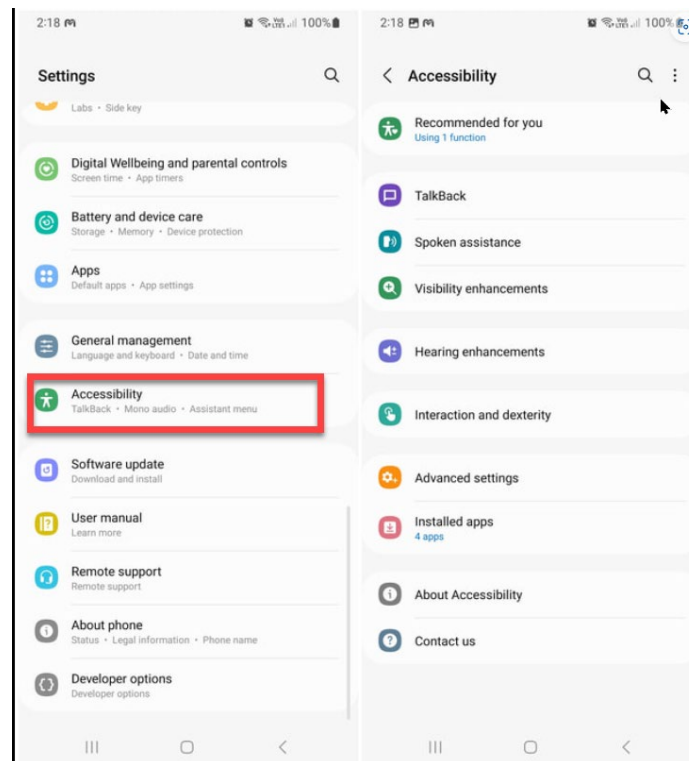


**Ease of Access** option.

## Step 2: Choose What You Want to Adjust

- **Text Size:** Make words on the screen bigger or smaller.
- **Contrast/Color:** Turn on high contrast or dark mode for easier viewing.
- **Magnifier:** Zoom in on parts of the screen.
- **Voice Feedback:** Turn on spoken content or screen reader.

- Change one setting at a time.
